
## FUND STRATEGY

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
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

## MACROECONOMIC UPDATE

June 2025 was another positive month for the Armenian economy: Economic activity index increased by 8.6% y/y. Construction, services, and trade were the main drivers of the economic activity during the month. Particularly: construction increased by a significant 22.6% y/y, services demonstrated a positive growth of 8.2% y/y, trade expanded by 2.8% y/y.

Foreign trade turnover for the same period decreased by 16.6% y/y to USD 1.73 bln Exports decreased by 15.9% y/y to USD 0.73 bln, and imports were also down by 17.1% y/y, reaching USD 1.00 bln Cumulative foreign trade net deficit expanded from USD 1.87 bln in May to USD 2.16 bln in June 2025.

As for the macroeconomic stability in Armenia, according to the preliminary data from CBA, the CPI increased by 3.9% y/y in June 2025. At the latest meeting of the Central Bank of Armenia the refinancing rate was maintained at 6.75% level. As of the end of July, compared to the previous month, the Armenian Dram slightly appreciated against the USD and EUR, standing at AMD 383.82 and AMD 439.01, respectively.

The Ministry of Finance allocated bonds with a total volume of AMD 100.60 bln during June 2025. As of the end of the month, the yield of 10-year AMD-denominated Government bonds decreased by 0.0340 pps m/m to 9.8432%
